






Physics activity

Before the interactive visit through our school, Bulgarian, Polish, English and Portuguese students presented some photos, notes and information about their countries and the previous CSI weeks






Interactive visit to the school using the CSI Toolbox activities

They visited our beaches and climbed the lighthouse *Farol da Barra*, one of the tallest in Europe. 
5TH MAY (THURSDAY): VISIT TO PORTO


CSI activities with Polish partners

Students and teachers involved in the project also saw the crime drama *Assault at the ATM*. Several students of different ages, several school grades and different subjects were involved in this activity which was an important focus of this Project

Visit to University of Aveiro


